



THE ROSEDALE PLANTSMAN'S LIST OF RECOMMENDED PLANTS FOR SHADE

All of the following woody plants grow well in both full sun and light or partial shade (less than 1/2 day of direct sun, or light filtered through a high tree canopy). Plants that grow well in more shade are identified as follows:

Plants with (*) - grow well in light to moderate shade.
Plants with (**) - generally prefer light or partial shade to full sun, and grow well even in moderate shade.
